8 SYNOPSIS: Current law permits the sale of alcoholic
9 beverages in certain locations.

10 This bill would provide that alcoholic
11 beverages may be sold by retail licensees of the

13 area of real property that consists of at least 160
14 acres or more if the real property is owned by the
15 same person or entity and is located partially in a
16 dry county and partially in a wet county.

22 Relating to alcoholic beverages; to provide that
23 alcoholic beverages may be sold by retail licensees of the
24 Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in any area of real
25 property that consists of at least 160 acres or more if the
26 real property is owned by the same person or entity and is

1 located partially in a dry county and partially in a wet
2 county.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law,
5 alcoholic beverages may be sold by retail licensees of the
6 Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in any area of real
7 property that consists of at least 160 acres or more if the
8 real property is owned by the same person or entity and is
9 located partially in a dry county and partially in a wet
10 county.

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
