BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- (a) This amendment shall apply only to territory located in Calhoun County.
- (b) Except as provided in subsection (c), any territory located in Calhoun County outside of the corporate limits of a municipality shall not be subject to the police jurisdiction or planning jurisdiction of the municipality if the municipality is not located entirely in Calhoun County.
- (c) This amendment shall not affect the police jurisdiction or planning jurisdiction of the City of Oxford in Calhoun County.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Section 284 and 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284 and 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
