8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose a local
9 constitutional amendment to provide that any
10 territory in Calhoun County outside of the
11 corporate limits of a municipality would not be
12 subject to the police jurisdiction or planning
13 jurisdiction of the municipality if the
14 municipality is not located entirely in the county
15 and would provide an exception for the City of
16 Oxford.

22 To propose a local constitutional amendment to the
23 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to Calhoun County;
24 to provide that any territory in Calhoun County outside of the
25 corporate limits of a municipality would not be subject to the
26 police jurisdiction or planning jurisdiction of the

1 municipality if the municipality is not located entirely in
2 the county and to provide an exception for the City of Oxford.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. The following amendment to the
5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
6 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
7 this act are fulfilled:

8 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

9 (a) This amendment shall apply only to territory
10 located in Calhoun County.

11 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c), any
12 territory located in Calhoun County outside of the corporate
13 limits of a municipality shall not be subject to the police
14 jurisdiction or planning jurisdiction of the municipality if
15 the municipality is not located entirely in Calhoun County.

16 (c) This amendment shall not affect the police
17 jurisdiction or planning jurisdiction of the City of Oxford in
18 Calhoun County.

19 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
20 shall be held in accordance with Section 284 and 284.01 of the
21 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284
22 and 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution
23 of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
24 state.

25 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
26 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
27 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

1 following description of the substance or subject matter of
2 the proposed constitutional amendment:

3 "Relating to Calhoun County, proposing an amendment
4 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that any
5 territory in Calhoun County outside of the corporate limits of
6 a municipality would not be subject to the police jurisdiction
7 or planning jurisdiction of the municipality if the
8 municipality is not located entirely in the county and to
9 provide an exception for the City of Oxford.
