21	officer includes a federal peace officer.
22	" <del>(a)</del> <u>(b)</u> A person commits the crime of impersonating
23	a peace officer if he falsely pretends to be a peace officer
24	and does any act in that capacity.
25	" <del>(b)</del> <u>(c)</u> Impersonating a peace officer is a Class C
26	felony."

1	Section 2. <u>Although this bill would have as its</u>
2	purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
3	expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
4	requirements and application under Amendment 621, as amended
5	by Amendment 890, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the
6	Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,
7	as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the
8	definition of an existing crime.
9	Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
10	first day of the third month following its passage and
11	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
