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2	ENROLLED, An Act,
3	Relating to Jefferson County; to establish a
4	cemetery board; to define terms; to provide for the members
5	and duties of the board; and to provide funding.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
7	Section 1. This act shall apply only in Jefferson
8	County.
9	Section 2. For the purposes of this act, the
10	following terms shall have the following meanings:
11	(1) BOARD. The Jefferson County Cemetery Board.
12	(2) CEMETERY. Any for profit cemetery in the county
13	where property is used or intended to be used for the
14	interment of human remains, including, but not limited to, any
15	property containing a grave, lot, crypt, niche, or mausoleum
16	and any gravestone, headstone, or other marker therein.
17	(3) MAINTENANCE. The act of maintaining a cemetery,
18	including, but not limited to, any of the following:
19	a. The cutting and trimming of the lawn, shrubs, and
20	trees.
21	b. Keeping in repair the drains, water lines, roads,
22	buildings, fences, and other structures located in the
23	cemetery.
24	c. The service and repair of machinery, tools, and
25	equipment used for the maintenance of the cemetery.

1	(4) NEGLECTED CEMETERY. A cemetery that has become			
2	abandoned or neglected in any of the following ways:			
3	a. Weeds, briars, bushes, or trees have become			
4	overgrown.			
5	b. Fences have become broken, decayed, or			
6	dilapidated.			
7	c. Graves, lots, crypts, niches, mausoleums, and			
8	markers and roads, buildings, or other structures in a			
9	cemetery have become damaged, broken, dilapidated, or			
10	destroyed.			
11	Section 3. (a) The Jefferson County Cemetery Board			
12	is created.			
13	(b) The board shall consist of five seven members.			
14	(c) One member of the board shall be appointed by			
15	each member of the local legislative delegation, and the local			
16	legislative delegation, by majority vote, shall appoint an			
17	additional member, who shall serve as the chair of the board.			
18	The members shall serve at the pleasure of the local			
19	legislative delegation.			
20	(c) Four members of the board shall be appointed by			
21	the members of the State House of Representatives representing			
22	any part of the county, and three members shall be appointed			
23	by the members of the State Senate representing any part of			
24	the county. The local legislative delegation, by majority			
25	vote, shall appoint one of the members to serve as the chair			

1	of the board. The members shall serve at the pleasure of the				
2	appointing authority.				
3	(d)(1) The initial board members appointed in				
4	accordance with subsection (c) shall serve the following				
5	terms:				
6	a. Two members appointed by a member of the House of				
7	Representatives and one member appointed by a member of the				
8	Senate shall serve a two-year term.				
9	b. One member appointed by a member of the House of				
10	Representatives and one member appointed by a member of the				
11	Senate shall serve a three-year term.				
12	c. One member appointed by a member of the House of				
13	Representatives and one member appointed by a member of the				
14	Senate shall serve a four-year term.				
15	(2) After the expiration of the initial term of				
16	office of each board member, the term of office for all board				
17	members shall be four years.				
18	$\frac{\text{(d)}}{\text{(e)}}$ The board shall meet quarterly and at such				
19	times as the board by a majority of its members agree.				
20	$\frac{\text{(e)}}{\text{(f)}}$ The board may adopt necessary rules or				
21	procedures to conduct its business.				
22	$\frac{\text{(f)}}{\text{(g)}}$ Members of the board shall serve without				
23	compensation, but may be reimbursed for actual expenses				
24	incurred while conducting the business of the board, according				
25	to its rules or procedures.				

1	Section 4. (a) There shall be established within the			
2	Jefferson County Budget Division, a Jefferson County Cemetery			
3	Account funded by revenue from the pistol permits portion			
4	dedicated to the Jefferson County delegation.			
5	(b) Board members shall serve on a volunteer basis,			
6	except that they shall be reimbursed for actual expenses that			
7	shall be verified and submitted to the Jefferson County			
8	Commission.			
9	Section 5. (a) The board shall be responsible for			
10	all of the following duties:			
11	(1) Negotiating the acquisition of any neglected			
12	for-profit cemetery in the county, including a cemetery owned			
13	by a private entity.			
14	$\frac{(2)}{(1)}$ Supervising the clean up and maintenance of			
15	any neglected cemetery under its authority.			
16	$\frac{(3)}{(2)}$ Coordinating with the sheriff to provide			
17	inmate labor to perform the maintenance of any neglected			
18	cemetery.			
19	$\frac{(4)}{(3)}$ Purchasing office equipment up to \$500 and			
20	other necessary materials to perform the functions of the			
21	board.			
22	(5) At its discretion, transferring the ownership of			
23	a cemetery under its authority to a nonprofit board.			
24	$\frac{(6)}{(4)}$ Any other business necessary to carry out			
25	the purposes of this act.			

(b) The board may only perform maintenance on a
private cemetery if the board finds after a hearing that the
condition of the cemetery is a public nuisance.

- (c) The board shall have the authority to enforce all rules adopted pursuant to this act and may institute any legal proceeding, including the filing of a suit, as necessary to effect compliance with this act.
- Section 6. (a) Subject to subsection (b), fifty

 Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) shall be made available to
 the board from the county general fund pistol permit fees

 collected by the county and twenty-five thousand (\$25,000)

 from the pistol permit fees for each year thereafter when the
 board takes action to acquire a for-profit neglected cemetery
 under this act. The funds shall come from the sales tax

 revenues deposited in the county general fund.
- (b) The funds made available for the purposes of this act shall come only from the sales tax revenues collected in the fiscal year 2016 and thereafter that is greater than the sales tax revenues collected and deposited in the county general fund in the fiscal year 2015.

Section 7. The county commission shall have no authority over the board and the county commission shall have no responsibility over a cemetery in the county, as defined by this act, and no county funds shall be expended as a result of the implications or implementation of this act.

1	Section 8. Members of the board may not be subject			
2	to civil liability arising from the conduct of the affairs of			
3	the board except when the act or omission of the member of the			
4	board amounts to willful or wanton misconduct, fraud, or gross			
5	negligence.			
6	Section 9. This act shall only apply to cemeteries			
7	in existence on the effective date of this act.			
8	Section 10. A cemetery owned by a religious			
9	organization, as defined by Section 45-37-150.01 of the Code			
10	of Alabama 1975, or a private, family-owned cemetery, is			
11	exempt from this act.			
12	Section 11. All laws or parts of laws which conflict			
13	with this act are repealed.			
14	Section 12. This act shall become effective			
15	immediately following its passage and approval by the			
16	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
