25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. (a) A cosmetologist who, for at least
27	three years, has held a current, valid cosmetology instructor

license issued by the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and 1 2 Barbering under Section 34-7B-24, Code of Alabama 1975, may 3 sponsor up to three apprentices at one time, provided that the licensee teaches and has taught in a school that is licensed 4 by the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and Barbering. 5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 6 first day of the third month following its passage and 7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 8
