Section 1. Section 16-33A-3 of the Code of Alabama 1 2 1975, is amended to read as follows: "\$16-33A-3. 3 "There is hereby granted to each eligible student 4 5 attending an approved institution the sum of \$1,200.00 three thousand dollars (\$3,000) per academic year, which sum shall 6 7 be distributed to $\frac{\text{the}}{\text{the}}$ institution on behalf of and to the credit of such the student in accordance with rules and 8 regulations to be promulgated adopted by the Alabama 9 10 Commission on Higher Education. Such grants shall be effective 11 for qualified students enrolled in academic programs 12 commencing after August 1, 1989." 13 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 14 first day of the third month following its passage and 15 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
