(c) The Department of Human Resources shall assign individuals subject to requirements established under 7 U.S.C. § 2015(d)(1), but not subject to requirements established under 7 U.S.C. § 2015(o), to an employment and training program as defined in 7 U.S.C. § 2015(d)(4).

Section 2. This act shall become effective on

January 1, 2021, following its passage and approval by the

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
