10 TO BE ENTITLED

13 Relating to Mobile County; to provide for the annual
14 salary of the two appointed nonmerit system personnel employed
15 in the Revenue Commissioner's Office of Mobile County.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Commencing on the first day of the month
18 immediately following the effective date of this act, the
19 salary of the executive secretary to the Mobile County Revenue
20 Commissioner shall be the same as the salary of the
21 secretaries to the Mobile County Commissioners, payable in
22 equal monthly installments upon warrants drawn from the county
23 treasury in the same manner as county employees.

24 Section 2. Commencing on the first day of the month
25 immediately following the effective date of this act, the
26 salary of the chief clerk of the Mobile County Revenue
27 Commissioner shall be sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000)

1 per year payable in equal monthly installments upon warrants
2 paid, one-half from the county treasury and one-half from the
3 state reappraisal budget. Thereafter, the chief clerk shall
4 receive the same cost-of-living increases granted to merit
5 system employees of Mobile County.

6 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
7 with this act are repealed. Act 81-508 of the 1981 Regular
8 Session (Acts 1981, p. 870), is specifically repealed.

9 Section 4. This act shall become effective
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
