10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Madison County; to provide for the
14 appointment of additional board members to the library board
15 of the City of Huntsville.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. (a) Upon the adoption of an ordinance by
18 the Huntsville City Council authorizing the appointment of two
19 additional members to the library board established by the
20 City of Huntsville, two additional board members may be
21 appointed to the library board of the city as follows:

22 (1) One additional board member may be appointed by
23 the Madison County Commission who shall be a resident of
24 Madison County.

25 (2) One additional board member may be appointed by
26 the City Council of the City of Madison who shall be a
27 resident of the City of Madison in Madison County.

1 (b) The library board member appointed by the
2 Madison County Commission may serve an initial term of two
3 years, and thereafter shall serve a term of four years. The
4 board member appointed by the City of Madison shall serve a
5 term of four years.

6 (c) The board after the effective date of this act
7 shall be known as the Huntsville-Madison County Public Library
8 Board and shall establish and maintain libraries as a part of
9 the Huntsville-Madison County Public Library. The board
10 members appointed pursuant to this section shall serve without
11 compensation and shall have the powers and duties of a member
12 of a library board established pursuant to Chapter 90, Title
13 11, Code of Alabama 1975. Public libraries established and
14 maintained by the board shall serve all citizens of Madison
15 County.

16 Section 2. The provisions of this act are
17 supplemental to existing law.

18 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
19 first day of the third month following its passage and
20 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
