10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Coosa County; to amend Sections
14 45-19-82.01 and 45-19-82.23 of the Code of Alabama 1975,
15 relating to the special recording fee and motor vehicle
16 ownership transfer fee assessed by the office of the judge of
17 probate; to increase the fees.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. Sections 45-19-82.01 and 45-19-82.23 of
20 the Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

21 "§45-19-82.01.

22 "(a) In Coosa County, a special recording fee of
23 ~~four dollars (\$4)~~ ten dollars (\$10) shall be collected by the
24 judge of probate, with respect to each real property
25 instrument and each personal property instrument that may be
26 filed for record in the office of the judge of probate and for
27 the recording of other instruments and documents in the

1 probate office in the discretion of the governing body of the
2 county, and no such instrument shall be received for record in
3 the office of the judge of probate unless the special
4 recording fee ~~of four dollars (\$4)~~ is paid thereon. The
5 special recording fee shall be in addition to all other fees,
6 taxes, and other charges required by law to be paid upon the
7 filing for record of any real property instrument or personal
8 property instrument, and for the recording of other
9 instruments and documents in the probate office.

10 "(b) The special recording fee ~~of four dollars (\$4)~~
11 ~~as~~ provided for by subsection (a) shall be deposited into the
12 county general fund.

13 "§45-19-82.23.

14 "Except as provided in this subpart, the judge of
15 probate may charge and collect the same fees that are provided
16 for by law. For the performance of duties relative to the
17 recording of the transfer of the ownership of motor vehicles
18 as prescribed in this code, the judge of probate shall charge
19 and collect an additional fee of ~~two dollars (\$2)~~ five dollars
20 (\$5). All fees shall be the property of the county and shall
21 be paid to the county general fund. Refunds for licenses
22 issued by mistake or fact of law shall be made under
23 conditions and in the manner prescribed by this code."

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
25 first day of the third month following its passage and
26 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
