SYNOPSIS:

This bill would require a public K-12 school or a local board of education to accept cash and any other form of payment of its choosing for admission to school-sponsored sporting events that are open to the public.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to education; to require a public K-12 school or a local board of education to accept certain forms of payment for admission to certain school-sponsored events.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. A public K-12 school or a local board of education shall accept cash as a form of payment along with any other form of payment of its choosing for admission to school-sponsored sporting events that are open to the public.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
