11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
12	Section 1. This act shall apply only in Cullman
13	County.
14	Section 2. For the purposes of this act, the
15	following terms shall have the following meanings:
16	(1) BOARD. The Cullman County Cemetery Board.
17	(2) CEMETERY. Any for profit cemetery in the county
18	where property is used or intended to be used for the
19	interment of human remains, including, but not limited to, any
20	property containing a grave, lot, crypt, niche, or mausoleum
21	and any gravestone, headstone, or other marker therein.
22	(3) MAINTENANCE. The act of maintaining a cemetery,
23	including, but not limited to, any of the following:
24	a. The cutting and trimming of the lawn, shrubs, and
25	trees.

b. Keeping in repair the drains, water lines, roads,
 buildings, fences, and other structures located in the
 cemetery.

4 c. The service and repair of machinery, tools, and
5 equipment used for the maintenance of the cemetery.

6 (4) NEGLECTED CEMETERY. A cemetery that has become 7 abandoned or neglected in any of the following ways:

8 a. Weeds, briars, bushes, or trees have become
9 overgrown.

b. Fences have become broken, decayed, ordilapidated.

12 c. Graves, lots, crypts, niches, mausoleums, and 13 markers and roads, buildings, or other structures in a 14 cemetery which have become damaged, broken, dilapidated, or 15 destroyed.

Section 3. (a) The Cullman County Cemetery Board is created.

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(b) The board shall consist of five members.

(c) One member of the board shall be appointed by each member of the local legislative delegation, and the local legislative delegation, by majority vote, shall appoint an additional member, who shall serve as the chair of the board. The members shall serve at the pleasure of the local legislative delegation.

(d) The board shall meet quarterly and at such times
as the board by a majority of its members agree.

(e) The board may adopt necessary rules or
 procedures to conduct its business.

3 (f) Members of the board shall serve without
4 compensation, but may be reimbursed for actual expenses
5 incurred while conducting the business of the board, according
6 to its rules or procedures.

Section 4. (a) The board shall be responsible for
all of the following duties:

9 (1) Negotiating the acquisition of any neglected 10 for-profit cemetery in the county, including a cemetery owned 11 by a private entity.

12 (2) Supervising the clean up and maintenance of any13 neglected cemetery under its authority.

14 (3) Coordinating with the sheriff to provide inmate15 labor to perform the maintenance of any neglected cemetery.

16 (4) Purchasing equipment and other necessary17 materials to perform the functions of the board.

18 (5) At its discretion, transferring the ownership of
19 a cemetery under its authority to a non-profit board.

20 (6) Any other business necessary to carry out the
21 purposes of this act.

(b) The board may only perform maintenance on a
private cemetery if the board finds after a hearing that the
condition of the cemetery is a public nuisance.

25 Section 5. (a) Subject to subsection (b), fifty 26 thousand dollars (\$50,000) shall be made available to the 27 board from the county general fund when the board takes action to acquire a for-profit neglected cemetery under this act. The funds shall come from the sales tax revenues deposited in the county general fund.

4 (b) The funds made available for the purposes of 5 this act shall come only from the sales tax revenues collected 6 in the fiscal year 2016 and thereafter that is greater than 7 the sales tax revenues collected and deposited in the county 8 general fund in the fiscal year 2015.

9 Section 6. The county commission shall have no 10 authority over the board, and the county commission shall have 11 no responsibility over a cemetery in the county, as defined by 12 this act.

13 Section 7. Members of the board may not be subject 14 to civil liability arising from the conduct of the affairs of 15 the board except when the act or omission of the member of the 16 board amounts to willful or wanton misconduct, fraud, or gross 17 negligence.

Section 8. All laws or parts of laws which conflictwith this act are repealed.

20 Section 9. This act shall become effective 21 immediately following its passage and approval by the 22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
