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PROPOSED AMENDMENT

4 (a) It is hereby declared to be the public policy of
5 Alabama that the right of persons to work may not be denied or
6 abridged on account of membership or nonmembership in a labor
7 union or labor organization.

(b) An agreement or combination between an employer 8 and labor union or labor organization which provides that a 9 10 person who is not a member of the union or organization shall 11 be denied the right to work for the employer, or where 12 membership in the union or organization is made a condition of 13 employment or continuation of employment by the employer, or where the union or organization acquires an employment 14 15 monopoly in any enterprise, is hereby declared to be against 16 public policy and an illegal combination or conspiracy.

(c) No person shall be required by an employer to
become or remain a member of any labor union or labor
organization as a condition of employment or continuation of
employment.

(d) A person may not be required by an employer to
abstain or refrain from membership in any labor union or labor
organization as a condition of employment or continuation of
his or her employment.

(e) An employer may not require a person, as a
 condition of employment or continuation of employment, to pay

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1 dues, fees, or other charges of any kind to any labor union or 2 labor organization.

3 (f) This amendment shall not apply to any lawful
4 contract in force on or prior to the date of the ratification
5 of this amendment but it shall apply in all respects to
6 contracts entered into after the date of the ratification of
7 this amendment, and to any renewal or extension of an existing
8 contract.

9 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 10 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 11 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 12 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 13 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 14 state.

15 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 16 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 17 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 18 following description of the substance or subject matter of 19 the proposed constitutional amendment:

20 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 21 Alabama of 1901, to declare that it is the public policy of 22 Alabama that the right of persons to work may not be denied or 23 abridged on account of membership or nonmembership in a labor 24 union or labor organization; to prohibit an agreement to deny 25 the right to work, or place conditions on prospective 26 employment, on account of membership or nonmembership in a 27 labor union or labor organization; to prohibit an employer

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from requiring its employees to abstain from union membership 1 2 as a condition of employment; to provide that an employer may not require a person, as a condition of employment or 3 continuation of employment, to pay dues, fees, or other 4 5 charges of any kind to any labor union or labor organization; and to provide a cause of action to an individual for damages 6 for denial of employment in violation of this proposed 7 8 amendment.
