- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 11 Section 1. Section 2 of Act 99-219 of the 1999 Regular
- 12 Session (Acts 1999, p.278), is amended to read as follows:
- "Section 2. (a) (1)—In Except as otherwise provided in
- 14 this section, in addition to all existing charges, fees,
- 15 judgments, and costs of court, the clerk, sheriff, or other
- 16 appropriate court official in the civil division of the
- 17 district and circuit courts of Tuscaloosa County shall
- 18 increase the fees by twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)
- 19 assess a fee of sixty dollars (\$60) per document personally
- 20 served by the sheriff's office, or its designee. For purposes
- of this act, the term "document" shall include multiple papers
- 22 served on a party or entity at one time.
- 23 (2) The process fee provided in this subsection shall
- 24 not apply to any civil documents issued specifically by the
- 25 circuit court or any mental health documents or orders issued
- 26 by the office of the judge of probate.
- 27 (b) The court official designated in Tuscaloosa County
- 28 by law for the respective courts shall collect the additional



29	service of process fee designated in subsection (a) <u>of this</u>
30	section and remit In the case of documents issued through the
31	circuit clerk's office, three dollars (\$3) of each fee shall
32	be retained in the circuit clerk's office and deposited in the
33	Circuit Clerk's Fund for operation of the circuit clerk's
34	office. In the case of documents issued by the office of the
35	judge of probate, three dollars (\$3) of each fee shall be
36	retained by the office of the judge of probate and used for
37	the operation of the office of judge of probate. The net
38	<pre>balance of the fees collected to the Tuscaloosa County</pre>
39	Commission General Fund for deposit in the fund to be expended
40	for law enforcement purposes shall be distributed as provided
41	herein: Fifty percent of the net balance shall be distributed
42	to the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund and used for the
43	operation of the sheriff's office; the remaining fifty percent
44	of the net balance shall be distributed to the Solicitor's
45	Fund of the District Attorney and used for the operation of
46	the office of the district attorney.
47	(c) In the case of documents requested to be personally
48	served by the sheriff's office in a civil case from outside of
49	this State, a fee of eighty-five dollars (\$85) shall be
50	collected by the sheriff for each document. Fifty percent of
51	these funds shall be distributed to the Sheriff's Law
52	Enforcement Fund and used for operation of the sheriff's
53	office. The remaining fifty percent of the funds shall be
54	distributed to the Solicitor's Fund of the District Attorney
55	and used for the operation of the office of the district
56	attorney."
