3 Section 2. A parent who is deployed in military
4 service outside of this state shall not be construed to have
5 waived any rights or protections with regard to custody of or
6 visitation with the deployed parent's child or children as
7 provided in a divorce decree unless the deployed parent
8 expressly waives the right or protection in writing.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
