18	To amend Section 14-3-58, Code of Alabama 1975,
19	relating to the escape of convicts; to provide for
20	notification of certain state and local agencies and the news
21	media when a convict escapes.
22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
23	Section 1. Section 14-3-58, Code of Alabama 1975, is
24	amended to read as follows:
25	" §14-3-58.
26	"(a) This act shall be known as the "Joel Willmore
27	Act."

1	" <u>(b)</u> Whenever any convict escapes, it shall be the
2	duty of the Board Department of Corrections to take all proper
3	measures for his or her apprehension, and for that purpose, it
4	must forthwith notify the following within 12 hours of the
5	escape:
6	"(1) communicate to the Governor the fact of such
7	escape, The Governor.
8	"(2) The Department of Public Safety.
9	"(3) The sheriff of the county where the escape
10	occurred.
11	"(4) The chief of police where the escape occurred,
12	if the escape occurred within a municipality.
13	"(5) The sheriff of the county where the last
14	conviction of the escapee occurred.
15	"(6) The chief of police where the last conviction
16	of the escapee occurred, if the conviction occurred within a
17	municipality.
18	"(7) The sheriff of the county where the convict's
19	home of record is located.
20	"(8) The chief of police where the convict's home of
21	record is located, if such location is within a municipality.
22	"(9) All electronic media outlets broadcasting from
23	within a radius of 75 miles from where the escape occurred,
24	including all radio and television stations.
25	"(c) The notification required in subsection (b)
26	shall include the time when and the circumstances under which
27	it the escape was effected, together with a particular

description of the convict, <u>including a copy of the convict's</u>

most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted and for

what offense and when;

"(d) In addition to the requirements set forth in subsections (b) and (c), the department shall post a notification on its website of the escape. The notification shall include the time when and the circumstances under which the escape was effected, together with a particular description of the convict, including a copy of the convict's most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted and for what offense and when.

"(e) The Director of Central Records of the

department shall enter the convict into the National Crime

Information Center within 12 hours of the convicts's escape.

"(f) The Department of Corrections and the board shall offer a reward, not exceeding \$400.00 four hundred dollars (\$400), for the apprehension of such the state convict, to be paid out of the proceeds of the labor of convicts in the State Treasury. But no warrant shall be issued for the payment of any such reward unless there is filed in the office of the Department of Finance the certificate of the board Department of Corrections that such the convict has been recaptured and restored to custody."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
