8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, applicants for license
9 to sell alcoholic beverages are required to file an
10 application, furnish certain information, and pay a
11 filing fee of \$50 to the Alcoholic Beverage Control
12 Board.

13 This bill would increase the \$50 fee to
14 \$100.

20 Relating to alcoholic beverages; to amend Section
21 28-3A-4, Code of Alabama 1975, to increase the fee to obtain a
22 license to sell alcoholic beverages.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. Section 28-3A-4, Code of Alabama 1975, is
25 amended to read as follows

26 "§28-3A-4.

1 "Every applicant for an original license issued
2 under this chapter shall file a written application with the
3 board in such form and containing such information as the
4 board may prescribe, which shall be accompanied by a
5 nonrefundable filing fee of ~~\$50.00~~ one hundred dollars (\$100),
6 and by the appropriate license fee as prescribed by this
7 chapter, together with the amount or amounts of the prescribed
8 license fee or fees, if any, levied or imposed by the county
9 governing body."

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
11 first day of the third month following its passage and
12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
