20	Section 1. Section 1 of Act 2003-195 of the 2003

24	(\$12,000) received by the Madison County Commission, pursuant
25	to Section 28-3-190(c)(2)t., Code of Alabama 1975, from the
26	excise tax on beer shall be distributed monthly by the county

commission to fund the Senior Citizens' Prescription Drug
Program in the county.

3 "(b) Commencing with the end of the 2017 fiscal year, ending September 30, 2017, and at the end of each fiscal 4 5 year thereafter, any additional funds in the account of the 6 Senior Citizens' Prescription Drug Program not expended for 7 the program shall be transferred to the General Fund of Madison County." 8 Section 2. This act shall become effective 9 10 immediately following its passage and approval by the

11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
