- 9 (a) This amendment shall only apply in Baldwin County.
 - (b) As used in this amendment, the following words have the following meanings:
 - (1) AIRCRAFT. Any contrivance now known, or hereafter invented, used, or designed for navigation of or flight through the air and used privately or commercially.
 - (2) FALSE OR SECRET COMPARTMENT. An enclosure integrated into a motor vehicle, aircraft, or vessel, that is a modification of the motor vehicle, aircraft, or vessel, as originally manufactured used to conceal or hide an illegal object or objects.
 - (3) MOTOR VEHICLE. A self-propelled vehicle intended primarily for use and operation on public roads and highways.
 - (4) VESSEL. Every description of watercraft capable of being used as a means of transportation on the water.
 - (c) (1) A person may not knowingly or intentionally own or operate a motor vehicle, aircraft, or vessel containing a false or secret compartment that is used or has been used to

conceal a controlled substance prohibited by Chapter 2, Title 20, Code of Alabama 1975, an object that is illegal to posses, or other contraband.

- (2) A person may not install, create, build, or fabricate a false or secret compartment in a motor vehicle, aircraft, or vessel that he or she or another person intends to use to conceal a controlled substance prohibited by Chapter 2, Title 20, Code of Alabama 1975, an object that is illegal to possess, or other contraband.
- (d) For the purposes of this section, a new owner of a motor vehicle, aircraft, or vessel is not criminally liable for any conduct in violation of subsection (b) which occurred prior to the transfer of title of the vehicle, aircraft, or vessel, provided he or she had no knowledge of the conduct and takes steps to change the motor vehicle, aircraft, or vessel back to its original design when made aware of the modification in violation of this amendment.
- (e) Notwithstanding Section 104, the Legislature may provide penalties for violations of this amendment by local law.
- (f) A motor vehicle, aircraft, or vessel containing a false or secret compartment used in violation of this amendment, as well as any items in the compartment, are subject to seizure by a state or local law enforcement officer with jurisdiction over the property. The procedures for forfeiture and the disposition of the property and any

proceeds shall be subject to Article 4, Chapter 5, Title 15, 1 2 Code of Alabama 1975. Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 3 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01 of 4 5 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the 6 7 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state. 9 Section 3.
