Relating to Jefferson County; to allow the employees of the Jefferson County Legislative Delegation Office to participate in the Retirement Systems of Alabama; and to provide the same type of benefits and protections of the Merit System Act.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. This act shall only apply in Jefferson10 County.

11 Section 2. There is hereby established the Jefferson 12 County Legislative Delegation Office. The personnel for the 13 legislative delegation office shall be selected and serve at 14 the pleasure of the delegation. The employees shall receive 15 the same benefits and be subject to the same rules and 16 regulations as employees of the state Merit System regarding 17 retirement, leave accrual and usage, and insurance benefits.

18 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the 19 first day of the third month following its passage and 20 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
