8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, there is no limit on the
9 number of athletic scholarships that may be awarded
10 to junior college students who permanently reside
11 in other states.

12 This bill would limit to four the number of
13 athletic scholarships that a junior college may
14 award to students whose permanent residence is
15 outside the state for each sport.

21 Relating to public junior colleges; to limit to four
22 the number of athletic scholarships that a junior college may
23 award to students whose permanent residence is outside the
24 state for each sport.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. During each academic year, a public
27 junior college may not award more than four athletic

1 scholarships for each men's and women's sport to students
2 whose permanent residence is outside the state.

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
4 first day of the third month following its passage and
5 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
