13 Relating to the City of Wetumpka in Elmore County;
14 authorizing the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages by
15 properly licensed retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic
16 Beverage Control Board and providing for a referendum.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. This act only applies in the corporate
19 limits of the City of Wetumpka.

20 Section 2. Subject to Section 4, the sale of draft
21 or keg beer or malt beverages for on-premises consumption by
22 retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control
23 Board is authorized within the corporate limits of the city.

24 Section 3. All ordinances relating to the sale,
25 consumption, and possession of bottled or canned beer shall
26 apply to draft or keg beer or malt beverages.

1 Section 4. The governing body of the city shall hold
2 a referendum to determine if draft or keg beer may be sold for
3 on-premises consumption. If a majority of the voters voting
4 thereon in the municipality vote in favor of the question,
5 then the sale of draft or keg beer for on-premises consumption
6 shall be authorized.

7 Section 5. The referendum shall be held at the next
8 city election or referendum election in Wetumpka. If a
9 majority of the voters voting thereon do not vote in favor of
10 the question, a subsequent referendum or referenda may be
11 held. A second or subsequent referendum shall not be held
12 within 12 months following a referendum which fails to be
13 approved by the voters of the city.

14 Section 6. This act shall become effective
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
