No transfer shall be made from 9 10 the appropriations fixed by law or required by subsections 11 (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), and (i) of Section 12 45-8A-23.144." 13 Section 2. This act shall become effective 14 immediately following its passage and approval by the 15 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
