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## 2 ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to the City of Winfield in Marion County; to authorize the city council to create a theater board; to provide for members and vacancies; to provide terms; to provide for the duties of the board; to provide for funding under certain conditions; and to ratify and confirm any expenditures made prior to the effective date of this act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The City Council of Winfield in Marion County may create a theater board to oversee the maintenance and operation of the Pastime Theater.

- (b) The board shall be composed of seven members appointed by the city council. The members of the board shall elect a chair. In the event of any vacancy on the board, the city council shall appoint a person to fill the vacancy.
- (c) The members of the board shall serve for three-year terms with the first terms being staggered by the council.
- (d) The board shall have all of the following
  duties:
  - (1) Handle the day-to-day operation of the theater.
- (2) Enter into contracts on behalf of the theater and schedule events on behalf of the theater.

- b. Any expenditures in excess of the budget shall be presented to the city council for review and approval prior to the expenditure being made.
- (4) Seek prior approval from the city council for any capital improvements, expenditures, or purchases in excess of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500).
- (5) Seek prior consent and approval by the city council of any and all grant requests and applications.
- (e) The city council shall place in its budget for the city a line-item for funding the theater, as funds are available, as well as amounts to cover the cost of insurance and facility utilities.

Section 2. Any expenditures made by the board or the city council on behalf of the Pastime Theater prior to the effective date of this act are ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
