## HB494 Enrolled

1 Enrolled, An Act,

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3 Relating to Tallapoosa County; to establish the Lake  
4 Martin-Tallapoosa County Tourism and Visitors Bureau; to  
5 provide for the board of directors of the bureau; and to  
6 authorize the board to receive and expend funds for the  
7 promotion of tourism.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. (a) The Lake Martin-Tallapoosa County  
10 Tourism and Visitors Bureau is established in Tallapoosa  
11 County for the purpose of promoting tourism in the county.

12 (b) The Lake Martin-Tallapoosa County Tourism and  
13 Visitors Bureau shall be managed by a board of directors  
14 composed of all of the following:

15 (1) Two members appointed by the Tallapoosa County  
16 Commission.

17 (2) One member of the City Council of the City of  
18 Alexander City appointed by the city council.

19 (3) One member appointed by the Alexander City Chamber  
20 of Commerce.

21 (4) One member to represent Wind Creek State Park  
22 appointed by the board members provided for in subdivisions  
23 (1) to (3).

24 (5) One member of the Dadeville Chamber of Commerce  
25 appointed by the board members provided for in subdivisions  
26 (1) to (3).

27 (6) One member from the hotel and lodging community in  
28 the county appointed by the board members provided for in



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29 subdivisions (1) to (3).

30 (c) The board may appoint additional advisory members  
31 as nonvoting members of the board.

32 (d) Each board member shall serve at the pleasure of  
33 his or her appointing authority.

34 (e) The board may receive and expend state, county,  
35 municipal, and other public funds and funds from private  
36 sources. All funds shall be expended to promote tourism in  
37 Tallapoosa County and in the Lake Martin and surrounding area.

38 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first  
39 day of the third month following its passage and approval by  
40 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
