1 Section 2. (a) The Alabama Peace Officers' Standards
2 and Training Commission shall investigate any and all
3 allegations of excessive force by local county and municipal
4 law enforcement officers, including allegations of excessive
5 force occurring up to three years prior to the effective date
6 of this act.

7 (b) The commission shall collect data for all
8 incidents, including the race of the officer and the victim or
9 victims, specific facts relating to the incident, whether the
10 incident was subject to court action and final disposition of
11 the court action, and the final determination of any local
12 review of the incident.

13 (c) Using the data collected under subsection (b),
14 the commission shall compile an annual report that shall be
15 presented to the House Public Safety and Homeland Security
16 Committee and the Senate Judiciary Committee. The report shall
17 include preventative measures that may be taken to train law
18 enforcement officers in a manner to reduce the occurrence of
19 incidents involving excessive force.

20 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
21 first day of the third month following its passage and
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
