19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. Section 16-11-2, Code of Alabama 1975, is
21	amended to read as follows:

23	(a) The provisions of this This chapter shall apply to
24	city boards of education unless otherwise provided by local
25	law pursuant to Amendment 659 to Section 104.01 of the
26	Constitution of Alabama of $\frac{1901}{2022}$ , or any other provision
27	of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 2022.
28	(b) The general administration and supervision of the

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29 public schools and educational interest of each city shall be 30 vested in a city board of education, to be composed of five members who shall be residents of the city, and who shall not 31 32 be the mayor of the city or members of the city council or 33 commission. In any Class 4 municipality which has adopted a mayor-council form of government pursuant to Chapter 43B 34 35 (commencing with Section 11-43B-1) of Title 11, the city board 36 of education may be composed of seven members.

- (c) No person individual shall be eligible for election or appointment as a member of a city board of education unless he or she satisfies all of the following qualifications:
  - (1) Is a person an individual of good moral character.
- (2) Has obtained a high school diploma or its equivalent.

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- (3) Is not employed by that city board of education.
- 44 (4) Is not serving on the governing board of a private elementary or secondary educational institution.
  - (5) Is not on the National Sex Offender Registry or the state sex offender registry.
    - (6) Has not been convicted of a felony.
    - of education are elected or appointed to represent a district, whenever a member of a city board of education moves his or her domicile from the district he or she represents, he or she shall cease to be a member of the city board of education, and a vacancy shall occur. The member shall provide notice of the move to the secretary of the city board of education before the beginning of business at the first meeting of the city

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(e) Any city or town which has had the general		
administration and supervision of the public schools and		
educational interests of the city or town vested in a city		
board of education for a period of 20 years or more prior to		
August 15, 1951, may, except as may be provided by law,		
continue to have general administration and supervision of the		
public schools and educational interest under a local board of		
education regardless of any past or future federal census."		
Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first		
day of the third month following its passage and approval by		
the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
