supernumerary court reporter who served 40 consecutive years
in the same circuit court, the spouse of such deceased
supernumerary court reporter shall be entitled to a monthly

allowance equal to 50 percent of the allowance received by the
 supernumerary court reporter from the state.

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective
4 immediately following its passage and approval by the
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
