SYNOPSIS: This bill would exempt Hospice of Marshall County, Inc., doing business as Shepherd's Cove Hospice; Hospice of Marshall County Foundation, Inc., doing business as Shepherd's Cove Foundation, including Shepherd's Cove Thrift Shoppe; and Palliative and Supportive Care Alliance, Inc., doing business as Shepherd's Cove Palliative Care from any state, county, and municipal ad valorem taxes and from paying or collecting any state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes.

TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To exempt Hospice of Marshall County, Inc., doing business as Shepherd's Cove Hospice; Hospice of Marshall County Foundation, Inc., doing business as Shepherd's Cove Foundation, including Shepherd's Cove Thrift Shoppe; and Palliative and Supportive Care Alliance, Inc., doing business

1 as Shepherd's Cove Palliative Care from any state, county, and
2 municipal ad valorem taxes and from paying or collecting any
3 state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. Hospice of Marshall County, Inc., doing
6 business as Shepherd's Cove Hospice; Hospice of Marshall
7 County Foundation, Inc., doing business as Shepherd's Cove
8 Foundation, including Shepherd's Cove Thrift Shoppe, which is
9 solely owned by the Hospice of Marshall County Foundation; and
10 Palliative and Supportive Care Alliance, Inc., doing business
11 as Shepherd's Cove Palliative Care are exempted from any
12 state, county, and municipal ad valorem taxes and from paying
13 or collecting any state, county, and municipal sales and use
14 taxes.

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
