10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Marshall County, to amend Section 1 of
14 Act 86-564, 1986 Regular Session (Acts 1986, p. 1151), as last
15 amended by Act 2012-480, 2012 Regular Session (Acts 2012, p.
16 1329), to provide further for distribution of the county's
17 share of in-lieu-of-taxes payments of the Tennessee Valley
18 Authority.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 86-564, 1986 Regular
21 Session (Acts 1986, p. 1151), as last amended by Act 2012-480,
22 2012 Regular Session (Acts 2012, p. 1329), is further amended
23 to read as follows:

24 "Section 1. In each fiscal year, the distribution of
25 the share of in-lieu-of-taxes payments of the Tennessee Valley
26 Authority for Marshall County shall be as follows:

1 "(1) Twenty-five percent of the total amount
2 allocated to Marshall County shall be distributed to the
3 Marshall County Board of Education, the Arab City Board of
4 Education, the Guntersville City Board of Education, the
5 Albertville City Board of Education, and the Boaz Board of
6 Education, on a per pupil basis based upon the student
7 enrollment of the respective schools on the last day of the
8 first monthly attendance report of each school year.

9 "(2)a. Four percent of the remaining 75 percent
10 shall be allocated for the operation of the Marshall County
11 Legislative Delegation Office.

12 "b. Any funds not expended for the operation of the
13 legislative office may be used for educational purposes or
14 industrial or economic development projects in Marshall County
15 as approved by unanimous consent of the legislative
16 delegation.

17 "(3) The remaining 71 percent shall be allocated as
18 provided herein and shall be reviewed by the county
19 legislative delegation every four years.

20 "a. Six percent of the remaining 71 percent or two
21 hundred thirty-two thousand dollars (\$232,000), whichever is
22 greater, shall be allocated to the Marshall County Economic
23 Development Office. These moneys shall be used to employ a
24 director and staff and to carry out the operation of
25 recruiting industries and job opportunities for Marshall
26 County and each of the municipalities in the county. The
27 director shall be employed by the Economic Development Board.

1 "All money previously allocated to the Marshall
2 County Economic Development Board which are accumulated and
3 held in a designated fund for industrial or economic
4 development projects in Marshall County are released for
5 further allocation at the direction of the board.

6 "b. Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) shall be
7 allocated to the Marshall County Commission to help provide
8 for school resource officers in the Marshall County school
9 system.

10 "c. Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) shall be
11 allocated to the Marshall County Economic Development Board in
12 addition to the allocation in paragraph a.

13 "d. Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
14 allocated to the Mountain Valley Council on the Arts
15 commencing on October 1, 2006.

16 "e. Thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000) shall be
17 allocated to the City of Albertville for ambulance use so long
18 as ambulance service is provided by the city; and twenty-seven
19 thousand dollars (\$27,000) shall be allocated to the City of
20 Arab for ambulance use so long as the ambulance service is
21 provided by the city.

22 "f. Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) shall be
23 allocated to Mountain Lakes Behavioral Health Care, for mental
24 health services, including substance abuse treatment and
25 prevention.

1 "g. Eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) shall be
2 allocated to the Marshall County Convention and Visitors
3 Bureau.

4 "h. Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
5 allocated to the Marshall County Coalition Against Domestic
6 Violence.

7 "i. Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
8 allocated to CASA of Marshall County, Inc., for services to
9 the aging and homebound.

10 "j. Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
11 allocated to the Marshall County RSVP.

12 "(4) All remaining amounts after the preceding
13 allocations shall be paid to the county governing body to be
14 distributed to the county and municipalities as provided by
15 law."

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
17 first day of the third month following its passage and
18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
