the City of Florence. The governing body of the City of

Florence, by ordinance, may regulate and permit the sale of

alcoholic beverages for on-premises <u>and off-premises</u>

consumption after 12:00 p.m. on Sundays by properly licensed

retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.

"(c) The governing body of the City of Florence shall hold a referendum to determine if alcoholic beverages may be sold for on-premises consumption on Sundays. If a majority of the voters voting thereon in the city vote in favor of the question, then the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption after 12:00 p.m. on Sundays shall be authorized."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
