5 TO BE ENTITLED
6 AN ACT
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8 To amend Section 36-21-181, Code of Alabama 1975,
9 relating to the membership of the Board of Commissioners of
10 the Alabama Firefighters Annuity and Benefit Fund; to provide
11 further for the board.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. Section 36-21-181, Code of Alabama 1975,
14 is amended to read as follows:

15 "§36-21-181.

16 "(a) There is created a board to be known as the
17 Board of Commissioners of the Alabama Firefighters Annuity and
18 Benefit Fund. The board shall be composed of the following
19 members:

20 "(1) A ~~consumer member~~ volunteer firefighter
21 appointed by the Governor for ~~an initial~~ a term of ~~two~~ four
22 years.

23 "(2) A volunteer firefighter appointed by the
24 Alabama Association of Volunteer Fire Departments for an
25 initial term of two years.

1 "(3) A volunteer firefighter appointed by the
2 Alabama Firefighters Association for an initial term of four
3 years.

4 "(4) A paid firefighter appointed by the
5 Professional Firefighters Association of Alabama for an
6 initial term of four years.

7 "(5) A paid firefighter appointed by the Alabama
8 Association of Fire Chiefs for an initial term of four years.

9 "(b) Thereafter, each member of the board shall
10 serve for a period of four years. Any member of the board
11 shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself. The term of
12 each person appointed or elected to the board shall begin on
13 the date of appointment or election, and any person so
14 appointed or elected whose successor has not been appointed or
15 elected shall continue to serve until the appointment or
16 election of a successor. Any member of the board who shall
17 cease to be a member during his or her incumbency shall be
18 replaced as a member of the board by the appointing authority
19 for the remainder of the unexpired term."

20 Section 2. The change provided in Section 1 shall be
21 effective upon the expiration of the term of the consumer
22 member serving on the effective date of this act.

23 Section 3. This act shall become effective
24 immediately following its passage and approval by the
25 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
