Relating to Shelby County in the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit; to provide for the assessment and collection of a solicitor's fee in certain civil cases; and to provide for distribution of the solicitor's fee.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. (a) In all civil cases in the district 9 and circuit courts in Shelby County, except for small claims 10 cases, a docket fee, hereinafter referred to as a solicitor's fee, shall be assessed in each case. The fees, when collected, 11 shall be distributed monthly as follows: Three dollars (\$3) 12 13 from each case to the circuit court clerk to be deposited into 14 the Circuit Clerk's Fund and to be used as provided by law for 15 the operation of the office of the circuit clerk and the 16 remainder of each fee to the solicitor's fund or district 17 attorney's fund in the county where collected or to the fund 18 in the county that may be hereafter prescribed by law for the solicitor's fee. The solicitor's fee in civil cases shall be 19 in the same amount as the docket fee or court cost which is 20 assessed in civil cases and distributed to the Fair Trial Tax 21 22 Fund.

(b) The solicitor's fee may be expended by the
district attorney for the payment of any and all expenses
incurred and for any legitimate law enforcement purpose.
