Relating to the Teachers' Retirement System; to authorize the officers and employees of the Alabama Higher Education Partnership, Inc., to participate in the system. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. (a) The governing body of the Alabama 8 Higher Education Partnership, Inc., by resolution legally adopted to conform to the rules prescribed by the Board of 9 10 Control of the Teachers' Retirement System, may elect to have 11 its officers and employees, from whatever source and in 12 whatever manner paid, become eligible to participate in the 13 Teachers' Retirement System subject to all rules, regulations, 14 and conditions thereof.

15 (b) The governing body of the Alabama Higher 16 Education Partnership, Inc., having made an election by resolution pursuant to subsection (a), may have its employees 17 18 and officers participate in, and be entitled to, all benefits 19 of the Teachers' Retirement System. Where contributions are made from salaries paid by the Alabama Higher Education 20 21 Partnership, Inc., the Alabama Higher Education Partnership, 22 Inc., shall pay the employer cost, calculated as a percentage 23 of the salaries of those employees, to be contributed as 24 employer contributions in accordance with Section 16-25-21, 25 Code of Alabama 1975. Such amount shall be paid monthly and at the same time as the member's contributions are paid to the
Teachers' Retirement System.

3 (c) The governing body of the Alabama Higher Education Partnership, Inc., eligible under subsection (a) to 4 5 participate in the system, may provide in its resolution to the Board of Control of the Teachers' Retirement System that 6 7 all service rendered by an eligible employee or officer to the 8 organization before the effective date of the election of the organization to come under the Teachers' Retirement System 9 10 shall be creditable service to the employee or officer. Such a 11 provision in the resolution shall apply only to those 12 employees and officers who were in the active service of the 13 organization on the effective date of the election of the organization to be covered under the Teachers' Retirement 14 15 System. The resolution shall also state that the organization 16 shall assume and pay, as required, all costs necessary to fund 17 the crediting of such prior service, with the costs to be 18 determined by the actuary employed by the Board of Control of 19 the Teachers' Retirement System.

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective 21 immediately following its passage and approval by the 22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
