Relating to Lauderdale County; to provide that the county health department shall perform site evaluation tests before the repair of an existing conventional septic system. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In Lauderdale County, notwithstanding all laws, rules, and regulations to the contrary, upon request by a property owner, the county health department or its duly appointed agent shall perform a site evaluation test for a fee of not more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) when such test is required for the repair of an existing conventional septic tank effluent disposal field.

14 Section 2. This act shall become effective 15 immediately following its passage and approval by the 16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
