24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. Section 28-11-7 of the Code of Alabama
26	1975, is amended to read as follows:
27	" §28-11-7.

"(a) Any person who distributes tobacco products within this state shall first obtain a permit from the board for each location of distribution. There is no fee for the permit. Each application for a permit shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable filing fee of one hundred dollars (\$100). There shall be no filing fee for a renewal. An annual license fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) is levied and prescribed for an initial tobacco permit when issued and shall be due and payable each subsequent year when renewed by the board.

- "(b) Any person who maintains a tobacco or tobacco product vending machine on his or her property in this state shall first obtain a permit from the board for each machine at each machine location. The permit for each machine shall be posted in a conspicuous place on the machine.
- "(c) A permit shall be valid only for the location specified in the permit application.
- "(d) A permit is not transferrable or assignable and shall be renewed annually. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if a location for which a permit is obtained is sold or transferred, the permit shall be transferred to the person obtaining control of the location and shall be valid for 30 days after the transfer during which time a new permit shall be obtained.
- "(e) If feasible, the board may, by rule or regulation, establish procedures for the issuance and renewal

1	of permits which combine tobacco permit procedures with the
2	application and licensing procedures for alcoholic beverages."
3	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
4	first day of the third month following its passage and
5	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
