ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to alcoholic beverages; to allow each state park that has a lodging facility and restaurant to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption Monday through Saturday except that in those facilities which currently allow Sunday sales alcoholic beverages may be sold for on-premises consumption each day of the week.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Each state park that has a lodging facility and restaurant ~~including any wet municipality in which the state park or portion thereof is located~~ may sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption Monday through Saturday, except that in those facilities which currently allow Sunday sales alcoholic beverages may be sold for on-premises consumption each day of the week. ~~, except that~~ The provisions of this bill shall not be applicable to any state park or municipality within Chilton County.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
