9 A BILL
10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
12

13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines
14 and corporate limits of the City of Springville in St. Clair
15 County.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits
18 of the City of Springville in St. Clair County are altered,
19 rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate
20 limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now
21 included, all of the following territory:

22 From the Northeast corner of the NE 1/4 of the NE
23 1/4 of Sections 12, Township 15 South, Range 1 East, go North
24 89°16'00" West, 699.09 feet to the Northwest right of way line
25 of I-59; thence, South 27°31'00" West, 265.78 feet for a point
26 of beginning; Thence South 28°14'51" West 580.68 feet along
27 the Northwest right of way line of I-59; thence, North

1 62°24'59" West, 305.63 feet to the center line of Simmons'
2 Mountain Road. Thence turn an angle to the right of 80°03'44",
3 tangent to a curve to the left which has a delta angle of
4 17°37'19" and a radius of 866.14 feet; thence, left along the
5 arc of said curve, 266.39 feet; thence, North 00°01'26" East,
6 166.23 feet; thence, South 83°24'00" East, 508.26 feet to the
7 point of beginning. And lying in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of
8 Section 12 Township 15 South, Range 1 East, St. Clair County,
9 Alabama.

10 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
11 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
12 proposed to be annexed to the City of Springville is on file
13 in the office of the Judge of Probate in St. Clair County,
14 Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

15 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
