ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Colbert County; to amend Section 45-17-233, Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the fee for pistol permits issued by the sheriff and to provide for distribution of the fee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 45-17-233 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-17-233.

~~"In Colbert County, the fee for issuance of a permit to carry a pistol in a vehicle or concealed on or about the person shall be five dollars (\$5) which shall be collected by the sheriff and deposited in any bank located in Colbert County selected by the sheriff, into a fund known as the Sheriff's Special Fund. Ninety percent of each fee collected shall be credited to the Sheriff's Special Fund. The fees may be drawn on and used at the sole discretion of the sheriff for law enforcement purposes and the operation of his or her office, including, but not limited to, the purchase of equipment, uniforms, materials, and supplies. Ten percent of each fee collected by the sheriff shall be paid into the general fund of the county and shall be used as other general fund monies are expended. The establishment of the Sheriff's Special Fund as provided for in this section and the use of~~

1 ~~the funds shall in no way diminish or otherwise affect any~~
 2 ~~other appropriation or funds now or hereinafter provided for~~
 3 ~~by law for the operation of the office of the sheriff.~~

4 "(a) In Colbert County, the fee for the issuance of
 5 a permit to carry a pistol as provided in Section 13A-11-75,
 6 Code of Alabama 1975, shall be fifteen dollars (\$15), except
 7 for persons age 60 and over, the fee shall be five dollars
 8 (\$5).

9 "(b) Each fee collected pursuant to this act shall
 10 be deposited by the sheriff in any bank located in the county
 11 into a fund known as the sheriff's law enforcement pistol
 12 permits fund. One dollar (\$1) from each fee shall be
 13 distributed on a regular basis to the county general fund. The
 14 remainder of the fund may be drawn upon by the sheriff or his
 15 or her duly authorized agent and shall be used exclusively for
 16 law enforcement purposes."

17 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
 18 first day of the third month following its passage and
 19 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
