8 SYNOPSIS: Existing law does not expressly allow a
9 municipality to license and regulate liquor stores
10 operated by the Alabama Beverage Control Board that
11 are located in its jurisdiction.

12 This bill would allow each municipality to
13 license and regulate liquor stores operated by the
14 Alabama Beverage Control Board that are located in
15 its jurisdiction.

21 Relating to liquor stores operated by the Alabama
22 Beverage Control Board; to allow each municipality to license
23 and regulate liquor stores operated by the Alabama Beverage
24 Control Board that are located in its jurisdiction.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of a law,
27 each liquor store operated by the Alabama Beverage Control

1 Board, where alcoholic beverages other than beer are
2 authorized to be sold in unopened containers, may be taxed by
3 the governing body of the municipality where the store is
4 located and subject to any ordinance of the municipality which
5 regulates liquor stores that are not operated by the board.

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
