1	"The taxes levied by this chapter shall not apply to
2	any legal entity which becomes dormant, even if the entity
3	fails to dissolve or to withdraw its qualification to do
4	business with the Secretary of State. An entity is dormant for
5	purposes of this section if for two consecutive years prior to
6	the taxable year it has not owned property, produced income or
7	carried out any business activity or function of any type."
8	Section 2. This act shall become effective
9	immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
10	its otherwise becoming law.
