4 Relating to Lamar County, to amend Section 45-38-101,
5 Code of Alabama 1975, to provide further for the compensation
6 and expense reimbursement of the county superintendent of
7 education.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 45-38-101 of the Code of Alabama
10 1975, is amended to read as follows:

11 "§45-38-101

12 Beginning with the next term of office, the county
13 superintendent of education in Lamar County shall receive an
14 annual salary ~~which shall not be more than 25 percent in~~
15 ~~excess of the highest salary paid to any other employee in the~~
16 ~~county school system. The salary herein provided for the~~
17 ~~superintendent~~ that shall be fixed by the county board of
18 education and shall be payable in equal monthly installments
19 out of the county funds available for ~~such~~ that purpose. In
20 addition to ~~such~~ the salary, the superintendent shall ~~furnish~~
21 ~~his or her own automobile and shall~~ be reimbursed for
22 ~~out-of-county and out-of-state~~ travel on official business at
23 the ~~rate of twenty cents (\$.20) per mile and on an actual~~
24 ~~expense basis for any other expenses incurred in performance~~
25 ~~of official duties~~ same per diem and mileage as provided to
26 state employees."

27 Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately
28 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
