3 To amend Section 16-22-1, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended by Act 2013-191, 2013 Regular Session, relating to the 4 5 appointment of police officers at certain educational 6 institutions; to grant such authority to the president or chief executive officer of Faulkner University. 7 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: Section 1. Section 16-22-1 of the Code of Alabama 9 1975, as amended by Act 2013-191, 2013 Regular Session, is 10 11 amended to read as follows: "§16-22-1. 12 13 "(a) The president or chief executive officer of any 14 state college or university, the president or chief executive

15 officer of the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind, the 16 Presidents of Talladega College, Concordia College, Samford 17 University, Birmingham-Southern College, Miles College, 18 Stillman College, Tuskegee University, Spring Hill College, 19 Faulkner University, and Selma University may appoint and employ one or more suitable persons to act as police officers 20 21 to keep off intruders and prevent trespass upon and damage to 22 the property of the college or university or of the institute. 23 These persons shall be charged with all the duties and 24 invested with all the powers of police officers. Any police

officer appointed by the President of Miles College shall be
restricted to the campus and property of Miles College.

3 "(b) Any person appointed to act as a police 4 officer, pursuant to subsection (a), while on duty, shall 5 carry and be trained in the proper use of a nonlethal weapon. For the purposes of this subsection, a nonlethal weapon is a 6 weapon that is explicitly designed and primarily employed to 7 8 immediately incapacitate the targeted person while minimizing fatalities and permanent injury. A nonlethal weapon is 9 intended to have a reversible effect on the targeted person. 10

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 13 first day of the third month following its passage and 14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

"(c) This section is cumulative."
