A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to Elmore County; to amend Sections 45-26-81.01, 45-26-230.01, and 45-26-242.01, Code of Alabama 1975; to further provide for the compensation of the judge of probate, sheriff, and revenue commissioner; and to repeal Section 45-26-81, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the salary of the judge of probate.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Sections 45-26-81.01, 45-26-230.01, and 45-26-242.01, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

"§45-26-81.01

(a) ~~Effective on July 1, 2020, the~~ The base annual salary of the Judge of Probate of Elmore County shall be ~~ninety-eight thousand dollars (\$98,000)~~ one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) per year, payable in ~~equal monthly installments from the general fund~~ the same manner and at the same time as other employees of the county. The salary provided by this section shall supersede any salary, expense allowance, or other compensation provided to the judge of probate ~~prior to July 1, 2020.~~

29 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, in addition to any  
30 other compensation provided to the judge of probate, the judge  
31 of probate shall continue ~~after July 1, 2020,~~ to receive any  
32 cost-of-living or other salary increases granted to county  
33 employees or elected officials in the county and as approved  
34 by the county commission or any salary increases as otherwise  
35 granted and approved by the county commission."

46 amount of one hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$130,000) per

50 the amount of one hundred forty thousand dollars (\$140,000)

53 more full terms as Sheriff of Elmore County shall receive a  
54 salary in the amount of one hundred fifty thousand dollars

61 ~~(a) Effective on July 1, 2020, the revenue commissioner~~  
62 ~~shall receive an annual expense allowance of sixteen thousand~~  
63 ~~dollars (\$16,000) per year payable in equal monthly~~  
64 ~~installments from the general fund of the county until~~  
65 ~~September 30, 2021. The expense allowance shall be in addition~~  
66 ~~to all other compensation and benefits granted the revenue~~  
67 ~~commissioner and may be treated as compensation for retirement~~

87 Section 2. Section 45-26-81, Code of Alabama 1975,  
88 relating to the salary of the judge of probate, is repealed.

89 Section 3. This act shall become effective on October  
90 1, 2024.
