8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose a local
9 constitutional amendment relating to Baldwin County
10 to define the Stockton Landmark District within the
11 county and to prohibit the annexation by local law
12 of any property within the district into any
13 municipality.

19 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of
20 Alabama of 1901, relating to Baldwin County, to define the
21 Stockton Landmark District within the county and to prohibit
22 the annexation by local law of any property within the
23 district into any municipality.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

25 Section 1. The following amendment to the
26 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become

1 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
2 this act are fulfilled:

3 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

4 (a) For the purposes of this amendment, the
5 "Stockton Landmark District" is defined as follows:

6 Starting at I-65 R2E and R3E go north to CR 96, go
7 west to Tensaw Lake. Follow meanders of Tensaw Lake to the
8 south until it meets the Tensaw River. Follow meanders of
9 Tensaw River until it meets with I-65. Follow I-65 in E/NE
10 direction to point of beginning.

11 Beginning at the point where I-65 intersects the
12 line which divides R2E and R3E, thence North to Little Halls
13 Creek, thence follow Little Halls Creek in a westwardly
14 direction to Halls Creek, thence follow Halls Creek to Tensaw
15 Lake. Thence follow meanders of Tensaw Lake in a southerly
16 direction until it meets the Tensaw River. Thence follow
17 meanders of Tensaw River until it meets I-65. Thence follow
18 I-65 in E/NE direction to point of beginning.

19 (b) No property within the Stockton Landmark
20 District may be annexed into any municipality by local law.

21 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
22 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
23 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
24 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
25 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
26 state.

1 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
2 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
3 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
4 following description of the substance or subject matter of
5 the proposed constitutional amendment:

6 "Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment
7 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to define the Stockton
8 Landmark District within the county and to prohibit the
9 annexation by local law of any property within the district
10 into any municipality.

11 "Proposed by Act _____."

12 This description shall be followed by the following
13 language:

14 "Yes () No ()."
