3	To amend Section 17-3-8, Code of Alabama 1975,		
4	relating to the meeting days of boards of registrars, to allow		
5	the Elmore County Board of Registrars to meet 187 days each		
6	fiscal year.		
7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:		
8	Section 1. Section 17-3-8, Code of Alabama 1975, is		
9	amended to read as follows:		
10	"\$17-3-8.		
11	"(a) Each member of the board of registrars in the		
12	Counties of Chambers, Clay, Cleburne, Coosa, Dallas, Escambia,		
13	Geneva, Lowndes, Perry, Sumter, and Wilcox may meet a maximum		
14	of 120 working days each fiscal year; each member of the board		
15	of registrars in the Counties of Barbour, Blount, Butler,		
16	Fayette, Greene, Lee, Marengo, Pickens, Pike, Randolph,		
17	Talladega, and Winston may meet a maximum of 168 working days		
18	each fiscal year, except in the Counties of Lee and Pike each		
19	board of registrars may meet up to an additional 30 session		
20	days each fiscal year, at the discretion of the chair of the		
21	county commission, and such days shall be paid from the		
22	respective county funds; each member of the board of		
23	registrars in Tallapoosa County may meet a maximum of 220		
24	working days each fiscal year; each member of the board of		
25	registrars in the Counties of Dale, Franklin, Houston, Marion,		

Marshall, Bullock, Macon, and Tuscaloosa may meet a maximum of
 216 working days each fiscal year; and each member of the
 board of registrars in the Counties of DeKalb, Elmore,
 Limestone, Russell, and Shelby may meet a maximum of 167
 working days each fiscal year.

6 "(b) In the Counties of Choctaw, Coffee, Colbert, 7 Cullman, Lauderdale, and Monroe, each member of the board of 8 registrars may meet a maximum of 199 working days each fiscal 9 year.

"(c) Each member of the Board of Registrars of 10 11 Autauga, Elmore, and Bibb Counties may meet a maximum of 187 working days each fiscal year. Each member of the Board of 12 13 Registrars of Walker County may meet a maximum of 200 days 14 each fiscal year and each member of the Board of Registrars of 15 Lamar, Cherokee, Clarke, Conecuh, Crenshaw, Hale, and 16 Washington Counties may meet a maximum of 140 days each fiscal 17 year. Each member of the board of registrars in the following 18 counties may meet the following maximum number of working days 19 each fiscal year: Henry - 140 working days; Covington - 188 working days; Jackson - 207 working days; Etowah - 207 working 20 21 days; and Lawrence - 140 working days.

"(d) Each member of the board of registrars in the
Counties of Baldwin, Calhoun, Chilton, Madison, Mobile,
Montgomery, St. Clair, and Morgan are authorized to meet not
more than five days each week for the purpose of carrying out

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their official duties. Jefferson County, which is now operating under the provisions of local laws, shall be exempted from the provisions of this section. Provided, however, that where the words "each year" are used in the local laws the words mean "each fiscal year."

6 "(e) The actual number of working days to be used as 7 session days shall be determined by a quorum of the board of 8 registrars according to the needs of the county.

9 "(f) As many as 25 of the allotted working days may 10 be used for special registration sessions (i.e., those sessions held away from the courthouse in the several 11 precincts of the county or sessions held on Saturday or 12 between the hours of 5:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M.). Notice of any 13 14 special session scheduled by the board shall be given at least 15 10 days prior to the special session by (1) bills posted at 16 three or more public places in each election precinct 17 affected, if the session involves precinct visits, and (2) 18 advertisement once a week for two successive weeks in a 19 newspaper published in the county or by radio or television announcements on a local station, or both by newspaper or 20 21 announcement."

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective 23 immediately following its passage and approval by the 24 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
