7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. (a) Commencing with the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2010, the Wilcox County Commission may 9 appropriate annually, out of the monies in the county treasury 10 11 not otherwise appropriated, an amount not exceeding ten 12 thousand dollars (\$10,000) into a fund to be known as the 13 "Contingent Fund," which may be expended for any county purposes not otherwise provided by law which in the judgment 14 15 of the Wilcox County Commission are in the best interest of 16 the county. Any sums remaining unexpended in the contingent 17 fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not revert to the 18 county treasury, but the amount of unexpended funds shall be 19 appropriated for the next succeeding year along with any funds 20 which may be appropriated for that succeeding year provided 21 the amount appropriated or expended in any fiscal year shall 22 not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
