"In addition to all other costs and charges in circuit, district, and municipal court cases in Colbert County, there shall be levied and assessed a court cost of twenty-five dollars (\$25) in all cases in which court costs are assessed which are determined by the judge to be domestic violence cases. The clerk of the each court shall collect the court costs and shall remit the proceeds quarterly monthly to the Office of the Chief Presiding District Court Judge of Colbert County to be distributed Alabama Coalition Against Domestic Violence after the deduction of one dollar (\$1) of the twenty-five dollars (\$25) fee in each case.
