8 SYNOPSIS: Currently, the fee for the issuance of a
9 "Helping Schools" license plate is \$20, which is
10 distributed to the local school districts.

11 This bill would provide that an owner of a
12 motor vehicle who is a resident of Alabama may
13 elect to pay an additional fee for the purchase of
14 a special license plate bearing the words "Helping
15 Schools."

21 To amend Section 32-6-300, Code of Alabama 1975,
22 relating to the fee for the issuance of a "Helping Schools"
23 license plate, to provide that an owner of a motor vehicle who
24 is a resident of Alabama may elect to pay an additional fee
25 for the purchase of a special license plate bearing the words
26 "Helping Schools."

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Section 32-6-300, Code of Alabama 1975,
2 is amended to read as follows:

3 "§32-6-300.

4 "(a) (1) Owners of all motor vehicles who are
5 residents of Alabama, upon application to the judge of probate
6 or commissioner of licenses, complying with the state motor
7 vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor
8 vehicles and payment of the regular license fee for plates as
9 provided by law for the motor vehicle, and the payment of an
10 additional annual fee of twenty dollars (\$20), shall be issued
11 license plates which shall bear the words "Helping Schools."

12 "(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision
13 (1) relating to the payment of an annual fee of twenty dollars
14 (\$20), each owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of
15 Alabama may elect to pay an additional fee in any amount for a
16 license plate bearing the words "Helping Schools."

17 "(b) The plates shall be issued, printed, and
18 processed in the same manner as other personalized plates are
19 in this chapter. The plates shall be valid for five years and
20 shall be replaced at the end of the period with either
21 conventional plates or other personalized plates, or with new
22 "Helping Schools" plates. Payment of the required motor
23 vehicle license fees and taxes for the years during which a
24 new vehicle license plate is not issued shall be evidenced as
25 provided for in Section 32-6-63. The State Department of
26 Revenue shall design, or have designed, the "Helping Schools"
27 plates in compliance with all laws and regulations."

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
2 first day of the third month following its passage and
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
